I liked the constant teaching and support in getting a role, allowing me to get past my anxiety with finding and securing a long-term position in a good company.

Through the generation programme I have been able to kick start my career in IT and get back on track from the ‘Covid speed bump’, it has allowed me to get back to where I want to be in life.

I have been able to save for a car, driving lessons and start saving for a house. it has changed my life totally.”
