




Youth Employment UK is a not-forprofit social enterprise actively tackling youth unemployment.


Youth Ambassador Case Study: Euan's Degree Apprenticeship Journey

In quarter 1 we launched two new Young Professional Online courses. These courses revolutionise the way young people explore their options. Based on the JET framework and mapped to Gatsby, CDI and Skills Builder Frameworks.

In response to the stark findings of our Youth Voice Census we launched a Mental Health & Wellbeing hub surfacing the the best support and guidance from across the sector

Across summer we launched the first of our virtual work experience programmes, following this we have proudly launched our McDonald's Virtual Work Experience and our newest Explore Careers In Hospitality and catering module.


